


**TREE IDENTIFICATION SERIES** 



Also known as: **Northern white pine** || Abenaki name: **Koa** [pronounced KOH-ah] || Latin name: **Pinus strobus** (*strobus* comes from the Greek word *strobos*, which means a whirling motion, probably in reference to the cone)
